STUDENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The SAP Referral System continues to be a helpful tool for students and staff. Some Year to Date information includes:

39 Referrals Year to Date

- 14 Referrals -36% for externalizing concerns
- 17 Referrals -44% for internalizing concerns
- 7 Referrals -17% for family concerns
- 1 Referral - 3% for social concerns

Of the 39 referrals, 22 of them are closed and have been connected to the necessary services/interventions and are now closed.
