Letters cannot be from family members. Include the person's relationship to you and their phone number. College entry form letters are not acceptable.
- 4. Enclose a copy of your birth certificate, naturalization papers, or passport information. All documents will be shredded immediately after review.

STUDENTS: Please submit the completed application and essay to your SCHOOL COUNSELOR by April 1, 2025.
